AHERA Asbestos Management Plan Yearly Notification

July 1, 2017

In accordance with the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA, Public Law 99-519), LCCTC facilities are surveyed every six months to inspect the condition of Asbestos Containing Materials (ACM). Inspections are performed every April and October by the LCCTC designated asbestos person. Every three years an inspection is also done by an accredited building inspector to insure the LCCTC stays in compliance with all State and Federal laws. The last triennial inspection was performed in October 2015 by Microbac Laboratories Inc. and no issues were found. Lawrence County CTC designated asbestos person is George Dudich, Head Custodian. Inspection of the LCCTC Asbestos Management Plan is available by appointment through the Head Custodians office during normal working hours.

No response actions are scheduled for the 2017-18 school year. During the 2017 summer break, the following asbestos containing material was removed. Academic and girl's locker room hallways- 6,900 square feet of floor tile and mastic.

AHERA regulations require a re-inspection every three years by an accredited building inspector. The next triennial update will be in October 2018.
