

Lawrence County Career and Technical Center Electrical Occupations Class Rules & Shop Dress Code

For safety reasons, students in Electrical Occupations are required to wear:

- Regular-fit blue jeans or coveralls
 (No baggy pants or sweatpants, nylon clothing or shorts)
- 2. LCCTC T-shirts (grey or black) provided by the school \$5.00 each
- 3. Leather work boots-must be tied
- 4. Long hair must be pulled back
- 5. No jewelry/earrings while in shop
- 6. No ball caps, hats or hoodies
- 7. Clear lens safety glasses must be worn at all times while in shop
- 8. No cell phones or electronic devices allowed in shop.

Disciplinary action will be taken if the dress code is not followed!
